HP STUDIOS

Connects artists with landlords and tenants of vacant and under-utilized spaces. The artists gain exposure and the spaces become activated through these collaborations.

ESTERIOSTUDIO

Was created in 2006 as Esterio Segura's personal studio. At the same time that the artist's work interweaves codes of other manifestations such as theater, dance, literature, and cinema; the studio space has been conceived as a cultural engine that creates projects that involve intellectuals and artists of different backgrounds. Its objectives transcend the character of a mere work and exhibition space, to become a device that opens up to the relation with the community through workshops, concerts, conferences and funding or support for artistic initiatives.



Esterio Segura has had a sustained presence in the international art circuits. In the last 30 years he has systematically exhibited his work in significant institutions from New York city, such as the Rubin Foundation, PPOW Gallery, the Bronx Museum, Queens Museum, Art in General Gallery and Times Square. Also, pieces of Esterio are part of public art collections in the city, such as the Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) and the Bronx Museum, and have been included in over 50 private art collections. Furthermore, in United States prestigious collections have acquired pieces from him, like the Cisneros Fontanals Collection, the Pérez Collection, the Arizona University Collection and, more recently, the National Gallery in Washington.

As result of his close relation with New York city, it is a pleasure for him to collaborate for the first time with the emerging project HP Studios.
