Influenced by his Cuban upbringing and his country's rich cultural heritage, self-taught Hector Frank's work is characterised by strong forms and lines of vibrant colours. His abstract 'Portrait Series' delivers solid outlines of human figures that are filled with striking designs that do not depict typical human features but are immediately captivating. He incorporates impasto techniques along with various mixed media and collage to build his images up off the canvas and brings them to life. His current works created from antique reclaimed wood with objects found in the streets of Havana capture the imagination. Hector remains at the creative edge of the ever-changing Cuban art scene.

Hector Frank's works have been shown in galleries throughout Cuba as well as in France, Belgium, Canada, Mexico, Malaysia and the United States. His work is collected internationally and resides in prominent collections world-wide. This is Hector's UK debut. Hector's first exhibit was in 2001 when he was 39.
